## 2017 SUMMER FINE ARTS CAMP TIME TO SHINE!

Our Fine Arts Camps are packed with fun and challenging activities that encourage creativity and growth for a lifetime. Campers will explore a variety of mediums such as graphite, paint, pastels, charcoal, sculptural materials, found objects, and much more. Each week includes art instruction, hand-building in clay, dance & drama, and a visiting guest artist. The Arts Center partners with the Moultrie Recreation Department to offer campers pool time once a week. On Friday from 1 pm to 2 pm, campers will perform their group dance & drama piece and display their works of art in a gallery style setting. We welcome families and friends to attend the Friday events.

### **June 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Drawing: African Art**

Campers will use African animals and patterns to sharpen their drawing skills. Camps include multiple works of art including a clay piece. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **June 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Basics**

Campers will be guided step by step through the process of creating and exploring line, four basic shapes, shadowing, composition, color, perspective, still life, and landscape as well as clay building. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **June 19<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 3-Dimensional Sculpture**

Campers will explore sculpture using found objects and plaster. This camp is a bit messy but lots of FUN! **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **June 26<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Nature and Design**

Campers will create a finished art collage using textiles and textures to explore a variety of areas in design. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **July 10<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Abstract with a Twist**

Using two famous abstract artists (Pablo Picasso & Jackson Pollock), campers will have fun studying and mimicking artistic styles and ideas to create their own masterpiece. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **July 17<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 COLOR (Let's Paint!)**

Treat your little artists to a week of exploring still life through drawing, color mixing, and using tempera and acrylic paints. This will be a great camp for a serious artist. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **July 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Mosaics**

Campers will dig in to the world of mosaics and study famous artists such as Antonio Gaudi to create their own artist-inspired work of art. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**

### **July 31<sup>st</sup> – Aug. 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Drawing: Funky Bones & Shells**

Campers will study figure, movement & core using skeletal structures and conch shells to build and develop drawing skills. **Note: Breakfast & lunch provided.**
